

Barby Local History Group

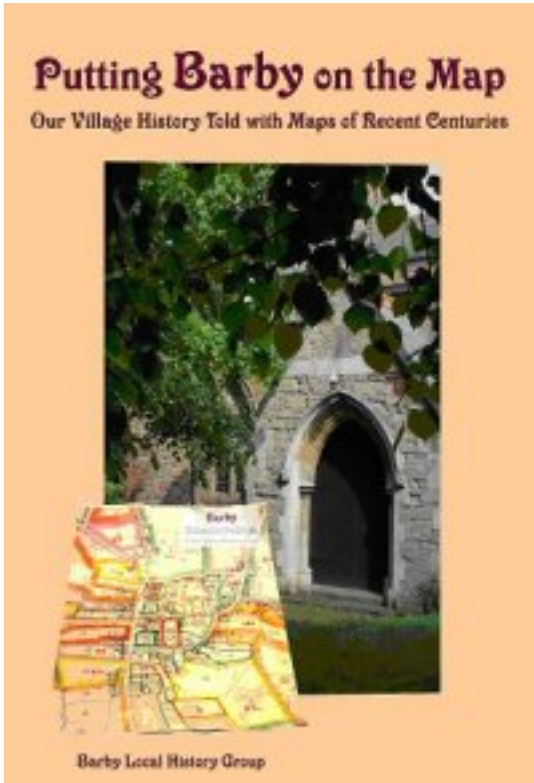
